Delimitation of study :

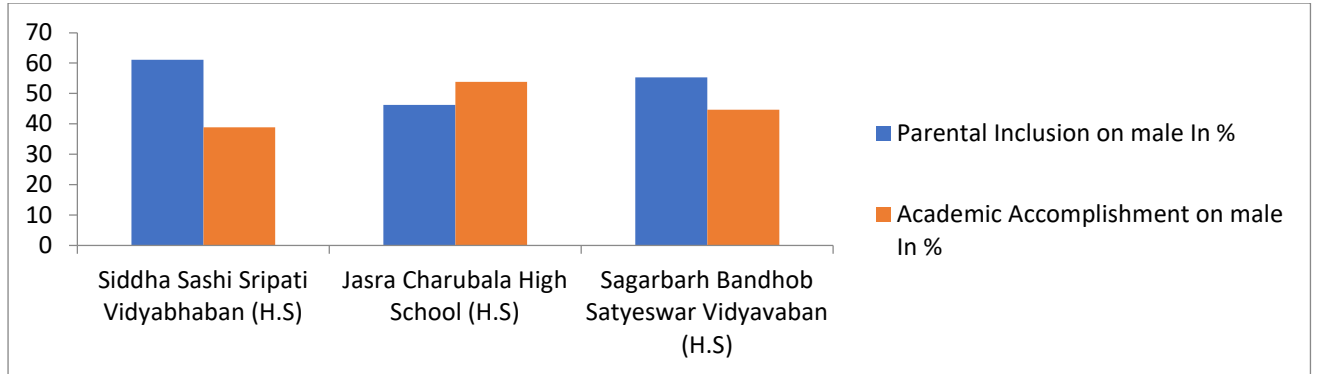
The work is delimited by 150 students of higher secondary level in 3 high schools of Purba Medinipur District , West Bengal.

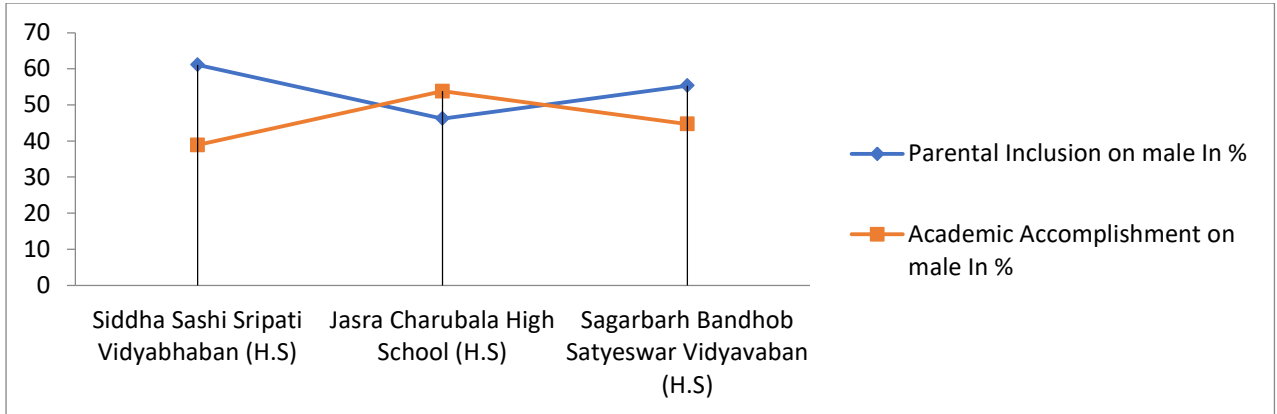

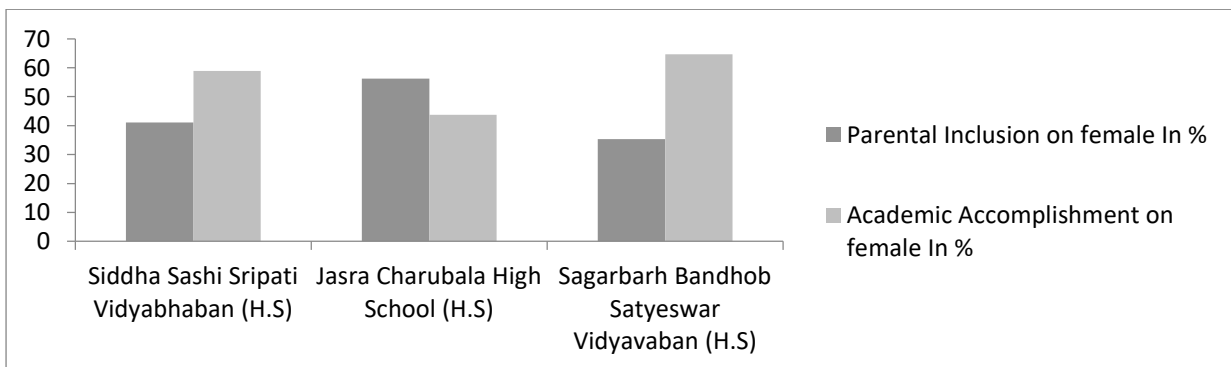

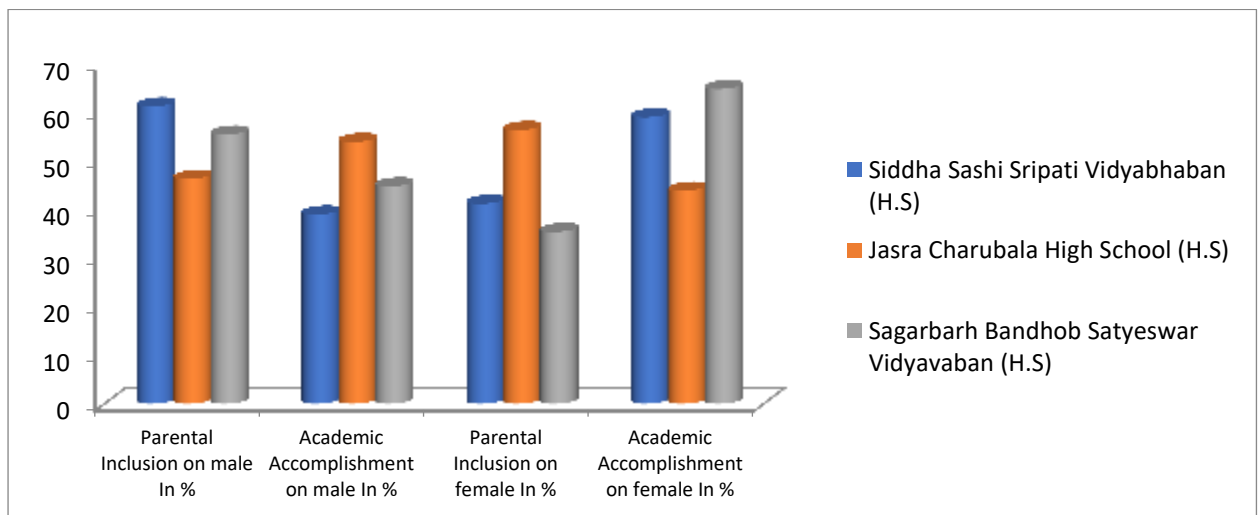
